4. Deployment of ERP software
 - PTA place on record is appreciation for the introduction of ERP
 - PTA was appraised of ongoing issues and feedback from the member were sought
 - To seek suggestions in improving the school functions and ensuring the use of technology to conduct classes and activities effectively
5. The PTA was appraised of the protocols in place to ensure student safety and accessibility during the construction changes to pick up point and school timings were also discussed
6. Deliberation on Non-payment of fees by some parents and recommended action against defaulters.
 - The administration staff to contact the parents who were defaulters to pay fees periodically. To schedule meeting with president so as to minimize the defaulter list.
